

Hoffman Cup Intragroup Play Statistics

April, 2016

Having completed eleven seasons, the Red Hoffman Cup Matches have reached a point where there is enough data to feed meaningful analysis. The following table provides a snapshot of the performances of the top ten point-earning clubs / teams in the heart of the Hoffman Cup – the intragroup play – since the start of the event in 2005.

Each year, every Hoffman Cup club competes against the three other clubs in its group to determine which one moves on to the Semifinals. In each club-versus-club match, 12 points are up for grabs; 36 is the maximum amount a club can earn in its group. This table looks at only the event's top-performing clubs (as defined by their intragroup points) and provides some insight into the Hoffman Cup.

An interesting observation is that only two of the top ten teams represent clubs with 27 or more holes. One would expect that a club with more holes would lead to more good players in the membership, and a stronger Hoffman Cup team. Another is the relatively few clubs that, upon joining the Hoffman Cup, have an immediate impact on the playoffs. **Montclair GC**, **Baltusrol GC** and **Black Oak GC** are clear exceptions, but every other team in this top ten has taken time to develop a consistently strong presence.

The information provided here displays the performances of the top ten point earners in the Hoffman Cup. We have collated these same intragroup statistics for each of the 32 Hoffman Cup clubs, all drawn from the Archives section of www.hoffmancup.org.
